How do I find out the result of my mitigating circumstances application?

February and May

Please note: At these points in the year most recommendations are provisional (therefore subject to change) and have not been ratified by an Examination Board.

February: Following semester 1 results publication, e-mail the [Student Support Office](#) who will aim to respond to e-mails within 1 week.

May: One week after the Mitigating Circumstances meeting, e-mail the [Student Support Office](#) who will aim to respond to e-mails within 1 week.

June /July

These Mitigating Circumstances Panels will consider all mitigating circumstances submissions made throughout the year and make a final recommendation to the Examination Boards in June/July.

Following semester 2 results publication, e-mail the [Student Support Office](#) who will aim to respond to e-mails within 1 week.

September

This Mitigating Circumstances Panel will consider all mitigating circumstances submissions made in relation to the resit period and make a final recommendation to the Examination Board in September.
