This year there were only 12 students attending this course unit and they have performed well in the exam, achieving an **average score of 18.08 points**, higher than last year's average (**17.87**). The improved performance is due to multiple factors: 1) the lecture notes have been improved year on year; 2) the number of quizzes in the classroom have been increased; 3) most of the questions have been sharpened up to reduce the ambiguity and vagueness. Last, but not the least, the credit should be given to the students who have performed well in the exam.
